

Boonsboro Public Safety Commission
Meeting Minutes
Thursday, March 17, 2016

Present: Chair Rick Byrd, Terri Hollingshead; Kristy Smith; Boonsboro Police Chief Charles Stanford

Mr. Byrd called the meeting to order just at 7 PM.

There were no citizens present to offer comment or concern.

Terri Hollingshead moved to accept the January minutes. Seconded by Marty Kristy Smith. Minutes accepted.

Old Business

Kristy Smith has not yet contacted the State Highway Administration. Terri Hollingshead reminded her of the names Mark McKinsey and Tony Crawford as the best contacts.

The council has approved the three way stop at Ford Avenue and Saint Paul Street and work will begin soon. The PSC recommends that a notice be sent to town residents about the new stop sign.

Street signs and no parking signs that had been previously requested are due to arrive this week.

We do not yet have follow up regarding the size of house numbers and if a new ordinance should be passed.

We have requested a budget of \$2,500 from the mayor and council. Budget decisions are pending.

New Business

In light of the speed study done on Park Drive, the PSC will recommend that the speed limit on all of Park Drive and Shafer Park Drive be changed to 20 miles per hour. This recommendation would include the extension that will eventually open from Shafer Park to the police station.

We will begin planning for National Night Out at our April meeting.

Boonsboro Police Department Report

Chief Stanford was present and was in favor of the change in speed limits to streets around the Shafer Park area.

Boonsboro Fire Department Report

There was no representation from the Fire Department.

Mayor and Council Report

There was no representation from the mayor or council.
