

BMUC 2015 Year In Review

Amended Billing Policy for all customers

Hired Operator at Wastewater Treatment Plant

Approved water/sewer rate plan and sent to mayor and council for approval

Replaced chlorine analyzer at Boonsboro Water Treatment Plant

Two from Wastewater Treatment Plant and one from Public Works passed their MDE license exam and became certified

Keedysville Springhouse rehab was completed

Received a 150000 dollar grant from A.R.C with matching funds coming from BMUC for sewer rehab

July 1, 2015, Water/Sewer rates were adopted and implemented

Replaced over 250 new meters resulting in decrease in water loss

Rehabed Schaffer Park well, lowered the pump and nearly got it back to previous pumping capacity

Installed new stainless steel pump and piping at Well 8

Created new position and hired a Water/Sewer billing clerk

Replaced all commercial meters in town of Boonsboro which should show a greater reduction in water loss

Purchased new truck for Sewer Dept.

Implemented new control testing at Wastewater Treatment plant resulting in better numbers for MDE

A generator was added at Keedysville Treatment plant

Accepted bid on sewer rehab, work scheduled to begin in the beginning of 2016
