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OWNER/APPLICANT AFFIDAVIT

This is to certify that I, _____
own the property at _____ and hereby will follow best
practices and management while having domestic hens on my property in accordance with Ordinance 2014-03
as follows:

1. No more than three (3) female chickens shall be kept on the property.
2. Eggs from the hens are for the personal enjoyment and will not be sold; nor will the chickens be bred for commercial purposes.
3. The chickens will be secured within the pen during daylight hours and will be within the henhouse during non-daylight hours. The henhouse shall be enclosed on all sides and shall have a roof and doors. Access doors will be locked at night.
4. All necessary action will be taken to reduce the attraction of predators and rodents and the potential infestation of insects and parasites shall be taken, including, but not limited to, the covering of opening windows and vents on the henhouse and the burying of the chicken wire surrounding the henhouse.
5. All necessary action will be taken to reduce the odors from chickens, chicken manure, or other chicken-related substances so it is not perceptible at the property boundaries.
6. All necessary action will be taken to reduce noise from the chickens at the property boundaries so it does not disturb persons of reasonable sensitivity.
7. The chickens shall not be slaughtered on the property.
8. Only motion-activated lighting shall be used to light the exterior of the henhouse.
9. Feed and water shall be placed in a location that is unavailable to rodents, wild birds and predators.
10. All stored manure shall be covered by a fully enclosed container or compost bin. No more than one, twenty (20) gallon container of manure shall be stored on any one property housing chickens. All other manure shall be removed. In addition, the henhouse, chicken pen and surrounding area must be kept free from trash and accumulated droppings. Uneaten feed shall be removed in a timely manner.

I further acknowledge that inspections of the coop and henhouse will be conducted, and any violations of Ordinance 2014-03 constitutes a municipal infraction and may be cause for the permit to be revoked.
