

BOONSBORO MUNICIPAL UTILITIES COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING
Wednesday November 18th, 2020

The Boonsboro Municipal Utilities Commission (BMUC) held its regular meeting on Wednesday, November 18th, 2020 in the Charles F. “Skip” Kauffman Building’s Meeting Chambers. Participants included Commission Chair Bob Sweeney and Commission Members Bobby Mose, Stu Mullendore, and Ken Eshbaugh. Also, in attendance were Mayor and Council Liaison Anthony Nally, Town Manager Paul Mantello and Pete Shumaker W/S Superintendent and Greg Huntsberry PW Superintendent . Commission Chair called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Monika Blassino and Andrew Cooper from WRA presented the draft wastewater system master plan and hydraulic model report.

The plan presents the system components requiring attention both in the current environment without additional development and with total build out of the properties acquire through annexation.

The data provided lays out all of the weaknesses in the system and shows what improvements need to be made and the cost of making those improvements for both scenarios. That is the system load as it exists today under peak conditions and the impact of development build out in the future.

The cost associated with each of these recommendations will be evaluated by BMUC and prioritized for future improvements.

Greg provided an update on the meter replacement program and all meters have been replaced.

Because of cold weather the water loss task force has been put on hold until spring.

The following projects were discussed and are currently underway.

- 1) Route 34 pump Station and streambank restoration
- 2) Park Lane sewer main replacement and re-paving
- 3) Wastewater treatment plant chemical contract and storage
- 4) The submission of the dewatering press Grant application
- 5) Wastewater treatment plant roof sealing RFP
- 6) Weir wall update
- 7) Wastewater treatment plant unused equipment. Member Eshbaugh recommended using the Town’s existing screw conveyor in the dewatering Project.

Mayor and Council Report – Mayor and Council Liaison, Anthony Nally, provided a brief summary of Mayor and Council activities since the last BMUC meeting.
