Tree board Update: Information was given about a pilot program for a tree give - away to town residents. Boonsboro will partner with Potomac Edison to give residents a free 5 gallon native tree to plant in the fall of 2021. More information about this program will be coming later.

Eagle Scout Project: Mayor and Council approved Ben Dellinger's project to plant up to 200 trees in the park. Potomac Edison will provide the money for a variety of native trees and weed mats. The project will be completed this fall. Isaac will notify Ben that the project has been approved.

Wagon Train - May 16: The ponies have been booked for the event. Additional information next month.

Green Fest - May 15: This will be a swap and recycle event only. There will be no vendors, food, or entertainment.

Independence Day celebration - July 2 - rain date July3: At this time fireworks are scheduled. The discussion on vendors will be at a later meeting.
