My name is Scott McIlwee and I'm the property owner of 202 Maple Avenue, Boonsboro, MD. This letter is to express my support of Senator Corderman's proposed FY23 LBI, "Chase Six Boulevard – Campus Drive Realignment & Intersection." As the Town's request proposes, I have agreed to exchange parcels of land, of equal size or greater, with the neighboring BOE's educational complex, and allow the realignment of Campus Drive, through the northeastern portion of my property.

Maple Avenue / Route 66 is a very busy road. Every day, thousands of vehicles pass my property, on their way to/from Hagerstown. Oftentimes, motorists are traveling much faster than the posted 30 MPH speed limit and there's no crosswalk to safely get students to/from school.

I am in full support of a lighted intersection connecting Chase Six Boulevard and Campus Drive. We need a safe pedestrian crossing and a lighted intersection. Thanks very much for your consideration!
