Fiscal Year 2024 Real Estate and Personal Property Tax Rates

The Boonsboro Mayor and Council held a Public Hearing as duly advertised on Monday, May 8, 2023 in the Meeting Chambers of the Town Annex Building. The Meeting was streamed via GoToMeeting. In attendance were Mayor Howard Long, Assistant Mayor Tony Nally, Council Members Terri Hollingshead, Marilee Kerns, Eric Kitchen and Ricky Weaver. Also present was Office Manager Kimberly Miller. Council Member Ray Hanson was not in attendance

Mayor Long opened the Public Hearing at 6:45PM for the purpose of receiving public input, either in support of or in opposition to the Fiscal Year 2024 Real Estate and Personal Property Tax Rates.

Mayor Long presented a fair summary of the proposed Fiscal Year 2023 Real Estate and Personal Property Tax Rates.

- Real Property Tax Rate: The Tax Rate on all Real Property located within the limits of the Town of Boonsboro is hereby set at \$0.3591 per \$100.00 of assessed property value. The assessed property values shall be those used for Real Estate Tax purposes as determined by the Washington County office of the State Department of Assessments and Taxation.
- Personal Property Tax Rate: The Tax Rate applicable to Personal Property located within the limits of the Town of Boonsboro is hereby set at \$0.875 per \$100.00 of assessed Personal Property. The assessed property values shall be those used for Personal Property Tax purposes as determined by the State Department of Assessments and Taxation.

Mayor Long opened the floor for public comment. No citizen comments were received.

Hearing no further comments, **Motion** by Assistant Mayor Nally, second by Council Member Hollingshead to adjourn the Public Hearing at 6:48PM. **Motion carried.**
