**Ordinance 2021-03; To Amend the Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance (APFO)**

The Boonsboro Mayor and Council held a Public Hearing as duly advertised on Monday, August 9, 2021 in the Meeting Chambers of the Charles F. Kauffman Building. In attendance were Mayor Howard Long, Assistant Mayor Rick Byrd, Council Members Marilee Kerns, Ray Hanson and Tony Nally. Also present were Town Manager Paul Mantello, Town Planner Reiley Stanley and Office Manager Kimberly Miller.

Mayor Long opened the Public Hearing at 6:45 PM for the purpose of receiving public input, either in support of or in opposition to Ordinance 2021-03; *To Amend the Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance (APFO)*.

Town Planner Stanley stated that the Ordinance is being recommended by the Planning Commission and the Boonsboro Municipal Utilities Commission, noting that the Water and Waste Water Systems Master Plans and Hydraulic Models will soon be completed and that developers will be required to use them when developing within the Town limits.
