Tree Board update:

Eagle scout project on Oct 10th- 250 trees to be planted

Tree locations on public property have been staked

Town crew will dig holes in advance

Trees will be delivered to sites on October 5th

Volunteers (15 from Potomac Edison/20 total) will gather on Thursday the 7th to organize and plant trees finishing up around lunch time. The grant will cover breakfast and lunch for volunteers.

Private trees will be organized near the scout building. On Saturday October 9th. A tree planting demonstration will take place at 9:00am. Individuals will be able to pick up their trees there. Volunteers will deliver the remaining trees to the homeowners after the demonstrations. To date there are 40+ individuals who have requested assistance planting trees. After deliveries have been completed volunteers will be dispatched to assist with plantings Saturday afternoon and likely into Sunday.

Movie night: Done for the season

There was a recommendation to consider doing Movie nights on Friday. The group felt that a late event on a work day did not seem advantageous and consensus was to leave them on Saturday for now. Other topics brought up included moving the movies to the old part of the park and perhaps including food truck(s). Additional discussion will be needed before next season
