*Bids for South Mountain Little League (SMLL) shall consider the following when providing a quote:

- Invoices shall be submitted separately to SMLL
- Mowing begins the week of March 20, 2016 and ends the week of October 16, 2016 (31-week mowing period)
- All four (4) fields (T-Ball, Major/Murphy, Minor/Crampton, and Junior/Senior) and Common Areas are to be mowed and trimmed.
- Anticipated frequency for mowing all areas is as follows:
 - March – 2 times per week (preferably Tuesday & Friday)
 - April - 2 times per week (preferably Tuesday & Friday)
 - May - 2 times per week (preferably Tuesday & Friday)
 - June - 2 times per week (preferably Tuesday & Friday)
 - July – once a week
 - August – once a week
 - September – once a week
 - October – once a week
- All mow and trim times will be performed Monday through Friday between 7 AM and 3 PM to accommodate practice and games schedules.
- No mowing or trimming during heavy dew and/or wet conditions will be performed to minimize damage to the playing fields and clumping of the grass cuttings.
- By mutual agreement revisions to the above and/or additional mowing and trimming cycles will be accommodated to the extent possible.
