

# Request from Fletcher's Grove HOA

Below is the topics that Fletchers Grove would like to discuss with the Mayor and Council at the meeting on the 12<sup>th</sup> of August. The topics have been refined by us after guidance provided by the Town Planner to the best of his ability.

- Request for striping on Tiger Way
  - Dedicated Left turn lane for traffic entering existing commercial area (Antietam Spirits/Domino's) off Tiger Way
  - Dedicated Left/Right Turn lanes at the end of Tiger Way for traffic exiting onto Chase Six Boulevard
  
- Chase Six and Main Street Intersection – dedicated left turn signals
  - The community asks that the Town speak with SHA if it would be possible to have dedicated left turn signals at the existing light on Chase Six Boulevard and Main Street
  - Traffic currently backs up to and at times beyond Tiger Way for those turning left, the community is concerned about traffic implications with school traffic once Chase Six Boulevard connects to Maple Avenue
  
- Options to mitigate speeders on the finished Chase Six Boulevard
  - Chase Six Boulevard would cut through our community and residents are concerned about traffic cutting through and speeding
  - Residents are asking if speed bumps, or speed cameras would be considered
  
- Clarification requested from our Townhome Residents:
  - Townhome residents have asked about the Town services they do not receive – such as road and drainage maintenance, snow removal and curb painting – if there would be an adjustment to their tax rates or accommodations otherwise
