RESOLUTION 2020-13
APPOINTMENT OF MUNICIPAL INFRACTION ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Boonsboro is a municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Title 6 of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Municipal corporations are authorized to establish by Ordinance the designation of certain conduct to constitute a municipal infraction or infractions; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-103 of the Local Government Article authorizes the legislative body of a municipality to appoint municipal infraction enforcement officers and to authorize such enforcement officers to serve municipal infraction citations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Boonsboro that PAUL MANTELLO and TIMOTHY LUNG be and are authorized and appointed to act as an enforcement officers in accordance with §6-103, to act on behalf of the Mayor and Council with respect to the citation and service of citations relating to municipal infractions, said appointment to continue at the pleasure of the Mayor and Council for as so long as this Resolution shall remain in effect.

A certified copy of this Resolution may be provided to the District Court of Maryland for Washington County for the purpose of establishing the authorization of the aforesaid enforcement officer in accordance with the applicable statute.
