A RESOLUTION OF BOONSBORO TOWN COUNCIL ADOPTING THE WASHINGTON
COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS the Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Town of Boonsboro; and

WHEREAS the Town has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the *Washington County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan*, in accordance with Federal Laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS the mitigation plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the town from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Council demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the *Washington County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Town of Boonsboro, Maryland, does hereby adopt the updated Washington County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan this 8th day of January 2024.
