Code Environment Article, Title 4, Subtitle 2, has repealed the above Ordinance and adopted new Ordinance "Washington County Stormwater Management, Grading, Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance" to meet the requirements of the Annotated Code of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Boonsboro has reviewed said new Ordinance and believes it satisfactory to protect the lives and property of Town residents; and


WHEREAS, Washington County has agreed to administer and enforce its new Ordinance within the corporate limits of the Town of Boonsboro;



Code 26.17.02 that the Town of Boonsboro hereby repeals Ordinance 2001-01 "Stormwater Management Ordinance for Washington County" and adopts Washington County Ordinance "Washington County Stormwater Management, Grading, Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance;" and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Washington County shall administer and enforce the provisions of said County Ordinance within the corporate limits of the Town of Boonsboro.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Boonsboro approved an Ordinance on August 6, 2001 to adopt the “Stormwater Management Ordinance for Washington County, Maryland”; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Boonsboro approved Resolution 2010-03 on October 4, 2010 to repeal Ordinance 2001-01 “Stormwater Management Ordinance for Washington County” and adopt Washington County Ordinance “Washington County Stormwater Management, Grading, Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance;” and

WHEREAS, Washington County, pursuant to Md. Code Environment Article, Title 4, Subtitle 2, repealed and reenacted with Amendments (Revision 1) the Washington County Ordinance “Washington County Stormwater Management, Grading, Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance” effective January 9, 2013 and furthermore made subsequent Amendments to Revision 1 effective February 26, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Boonsboro has reviewed said repealed and reenacted Ordinance, effective February 26, 2013, and believes it satisfactory to protect the lives and property of Town residents; and

WHEREAS, Washington County has agreed to administer and enforce the “Washington County Stormwater Management, Grading, Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance” within the corporate limits of the Town of Boonsboro; and

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and resolved by the Mayor and Council of Boonsboro, pursuant to Md. Code 26.17.02 that the Town of Boonsboro hereby adopts Washington County Ordinance “Washington County Stormwater Management, Grading, Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance” (Revision 1 as amended, effective February 26, 2013), as amended, revised, and supplemented from time to time, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Washington County shall administer and enforce the provisions of said County Ordinance within the corporate limits of the Town of Boonsboro.
