

**TOWN OF BOONSBORO  
LEGAL NOTICE  
PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, February 10, 2020 the Mayor and Council of Boonsboro will hold a Public Hearing at 6:30 P.M. in the Charles F. Kauffman Jr. Meeting Chambers (19 North Main Street) to receive public input on the Ordinance 2020-01: Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Ordinance, which was introduced on January 21, 2020 by the Mayor and Council of Boonsboro. A fair summary of Ordinance 2020-01 is set forth below:

The ordinance provides for the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the Town of Boonsboro through the regulation of non-storm water discharges to the storm drainage system to the maximum extent practicable as required by Federal and State law. The ordinance will establish methods for controlling the introduction of pollutants into the municipal separate storm water system in order to comply with requirements set forth under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit No. 13-IM-5500 for discharges from the Town of Boonsboro's small municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4).

The Ordinance may be reviewed during regular business hours at the Boonsboro Town Hall located at 21 N. Main Street in Boonsboro, MD or online at [town.boonsboro.md.us](http://town.boonsboro.md.us). If approved, the ordinance will become effective twenty (20) days from the time of passage.
